Activities in Evesham

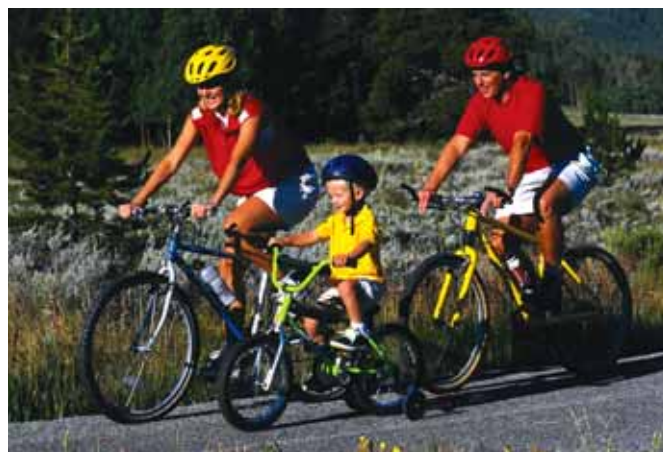


Evesham is ideally placed between the Malverns, Bredon Hill and the Cotswolds. Evesham is known as one of the most abundant fruit and vegetable areas in the country. From early March to early May, Evesham becomes a mass of blossom!

Walking, Cycling and Driving – The Blossom Trail and Cotswold Way

“For a few short weeks between mid March and mid May, the roadsides are ablaze with colour. These walks, cycle routes and drives have been devised with springtime blossom in mind, however they can be appreciated at any time of year. To celebrate the Blossom Trails 25th Birthday it is being extended. The famous yellow AA signs will not only direct you through the delightful Vale of Evesham, it will also now give you the opportunity to explore the Cotswold village of Broadway. A 45 mile route of natural beauty at its best. Explore and enjoy the open countryside and beautiful villages that the area has to offer and stop for a bite to eat at one of the many country pubs along the way.”

Enjoy a leisurely 3 mile stroll, starting from All Saints in Church Lench or a 4 and a half mile walk from Fladbury. These walks, mainly through rolling countryside have open views of the surrounding area and go through bird sanctuaries and nature reserves.



The Blossom trail cycle route is waymarked – so look out for the blue signs. The cycle route starts from Evesham Railway Station.

Cycling

Bredon Hill and the Cotswolds trails provide more challenging rides.

Abbey Park

The Abbey Church was dismantled however the twin churches of All Saints, St. Lawrence and Abbott Lichfield's 16th Century Bell tower can still be seen from the stunning grounds of the Abbey Park. The Park is a beautiful place to be and together with the riverside meadows hold numerous exciting events throughout the year.

The Park is also a very relaxing place to be, pick one of the many beautiful mature trees to sit under and peacefully read a book, have a sleep or watch the world go by - the choice is yours.

For the Children

If you walk through the Park, you will stumble upon various activities from the children's adventure play grounds, water play area and crazy golf.

For the rainy days there is Evesham Leisure Centre offering swimming and sports facilities (www.wychavonleisure.co.uk). For children who like soft play areas, in Evesham there is a Wacky Warehouse as well as Bungo's Barn in nearby Bidford-on-Avon (www.bungos-playbarn.co.uk)

Fishing

Fishing contests are also very popular together with the renowned Evesham Regatta. Berryfield House B&B is only a 5 minute walk from the riverside and therefore is a convenient base.

Golf

Evesham has a its own golf course (www.eveshamgolfclub.co.uk) and also a new driving range at Twyford (www.twyfordgolf.com). More courses are available in the surrounding area.



Shopping

Evesham's main shopping centre has recently been refurbished housing numerous large brand named shops to smaller individual retail shops giving visitors the best of both worlds!



Evesham Country Park is also a lovely day out for the whole family. From browsing around a superb Garden Centre to experiencing The Ark Animal Sanctuary and then travelling on a 15" gauge miniature steam passenger railway train to a picnic area - it is definitely not to be left off your "to do list"!



Eating Out

Whatever cuisine you are after, from Italian to Thai, English to Chinese, Evesham will satisfy your tastes. The town centre has a host of restaurants and takeaways. Waterside and Port Street boast a high concentration of Chinese and Indian Restaurants with a flavour of Italian thrown into the mix.

Bookings must be accompanied with a 50% deposit by credit card or cheque. Cheques must be posted in advance to allow them to clear.

Check-in is between 4pm and 10pm. Outside these hours is by arrangement only.

Terms and Conditions

All accommodation is offered subject to availability at time of receipt of deposit and at the tariffs applicable according to season.

Meal times are prearranged and no allowance can be made for meals not taken.

Rooms must be vacated by 10.00am on the day of departure.

The proprietors cannot accept responsibility for the loss of guests' property unless handed in for safe custody.

Accounts must be paid on arrival and cheques will only be accepted if prior arrangements have been made with the proprietor to allow for bank clearance.

In the event of a cancellation or curtailment, should the accommodation not be re-let, the person who booked the room will be liable to pay for the total cost as per the reservation.

Deposits are not refundable but will be deductible from any claim for compensation arising out of any cancellation or curtailment of the contract.

If the deposit has been paid using a credit card authorised account number, then any payment due, owing to cancellation, will also be made on this same account number by the proprietor.

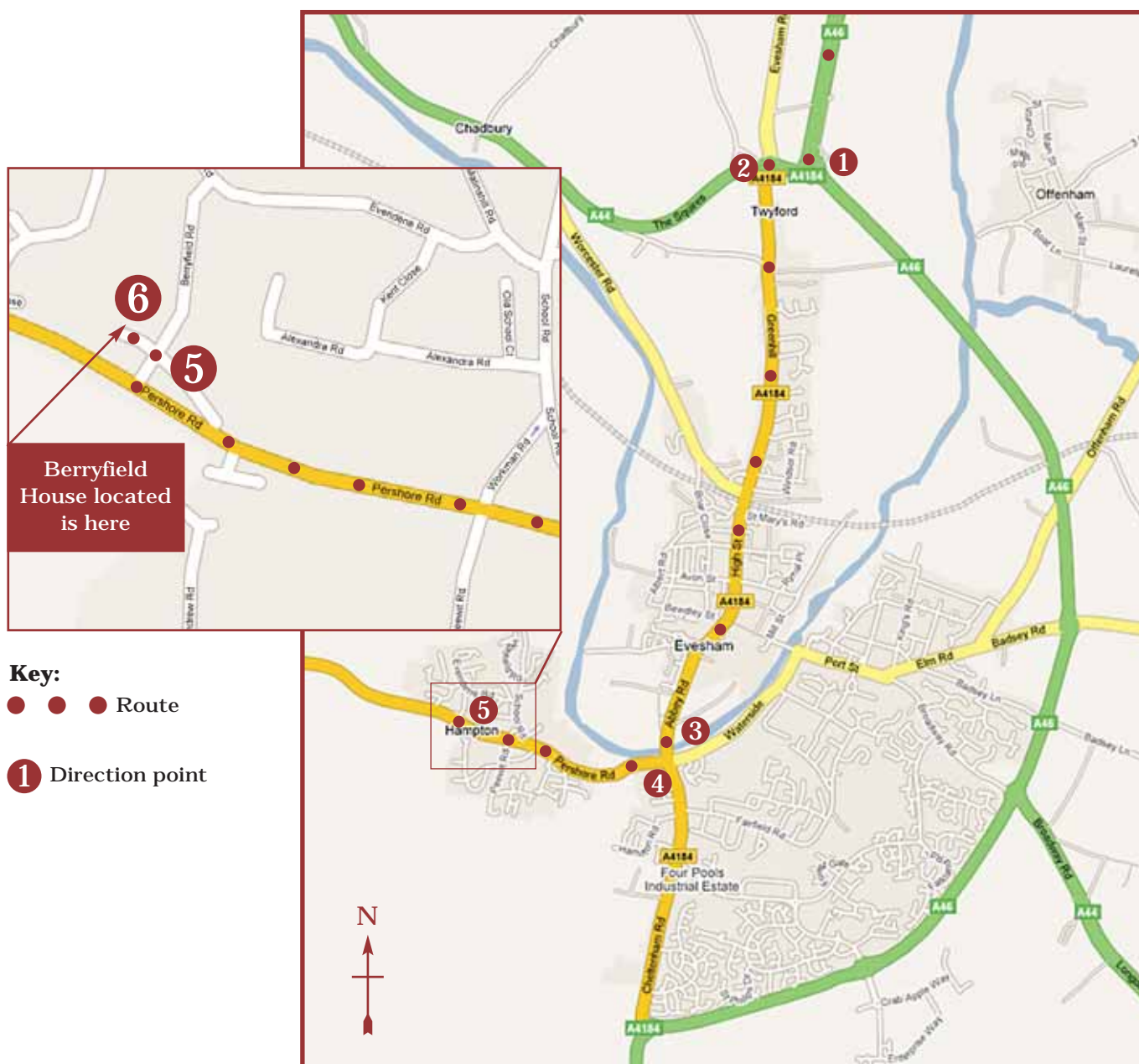

Directions - From the North

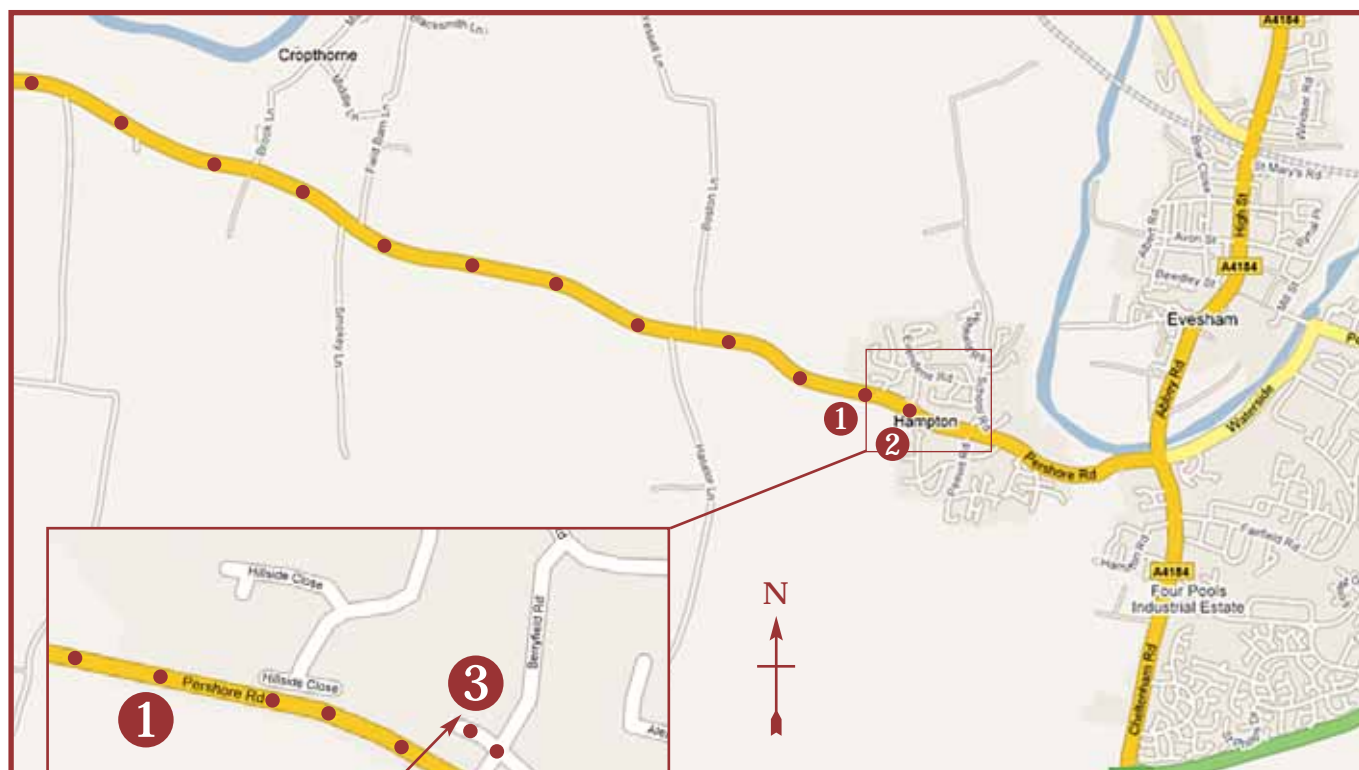


From J15 M40

Leave the M40 at J15. Follow the A46 towards Stratford-upon-Avon
Keep on the A46 past Stratford-upon-Avon towards Evesham.

- 1 Just north of Evesham turn right at the large roundabout next to the services onto the A4184.
- 2 At the next roundabout take the first exit towards Evesham A4184
- 3 Go through the town staying on the A4184 until you reach the large bridge over the Avon just past the playing fields on the left.
- 4 At the traffic lights at the bridge turn right onto the B4084.
- 5 After 0.7 miles turn right into Berryfield Road, and then immediate left.
- 6 Berryfield House will be on your right

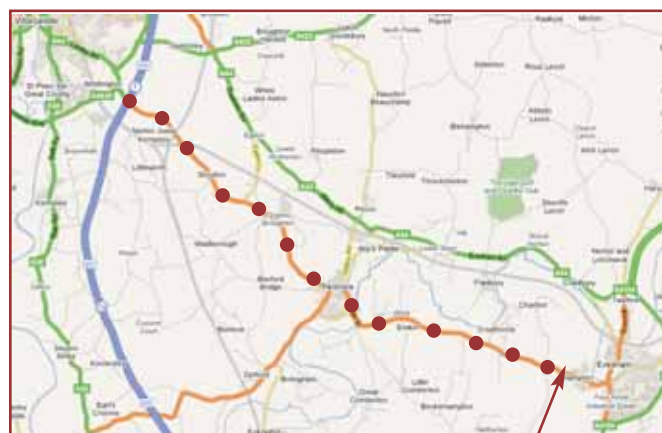
Directions - From the West

Stay on the B4084 through Pershore and follow the signs towards Evesham.

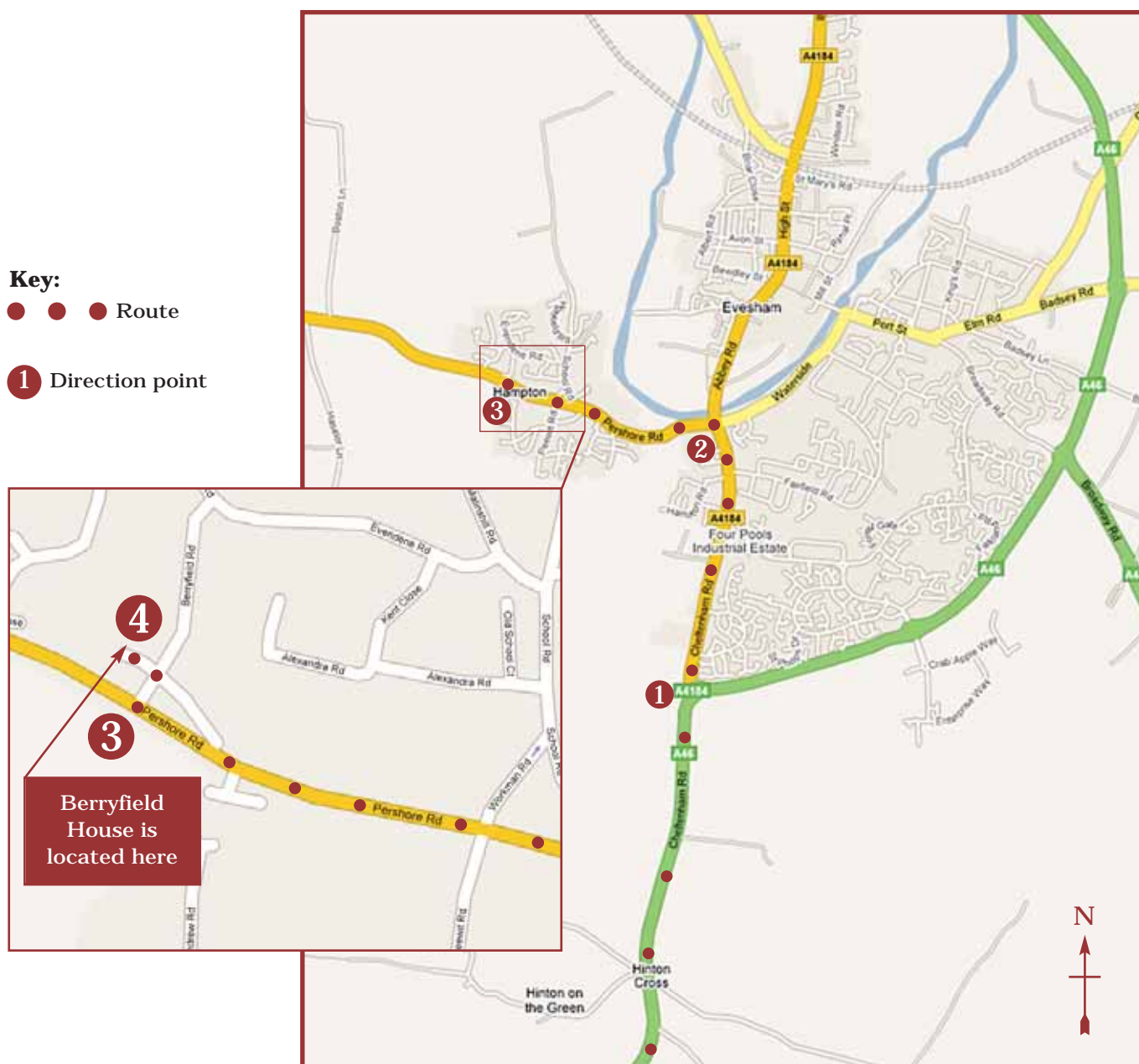
- 1 As you enter Evesham, Berryfield House is located 200m on the left hand side.
- 2 Turn left into Berryfield Road, and then immediate left.
- 3 Berryfield House will be on your right.

From J9 M5

Leave the M5 at J9

Follow the A46 towards Evesham.

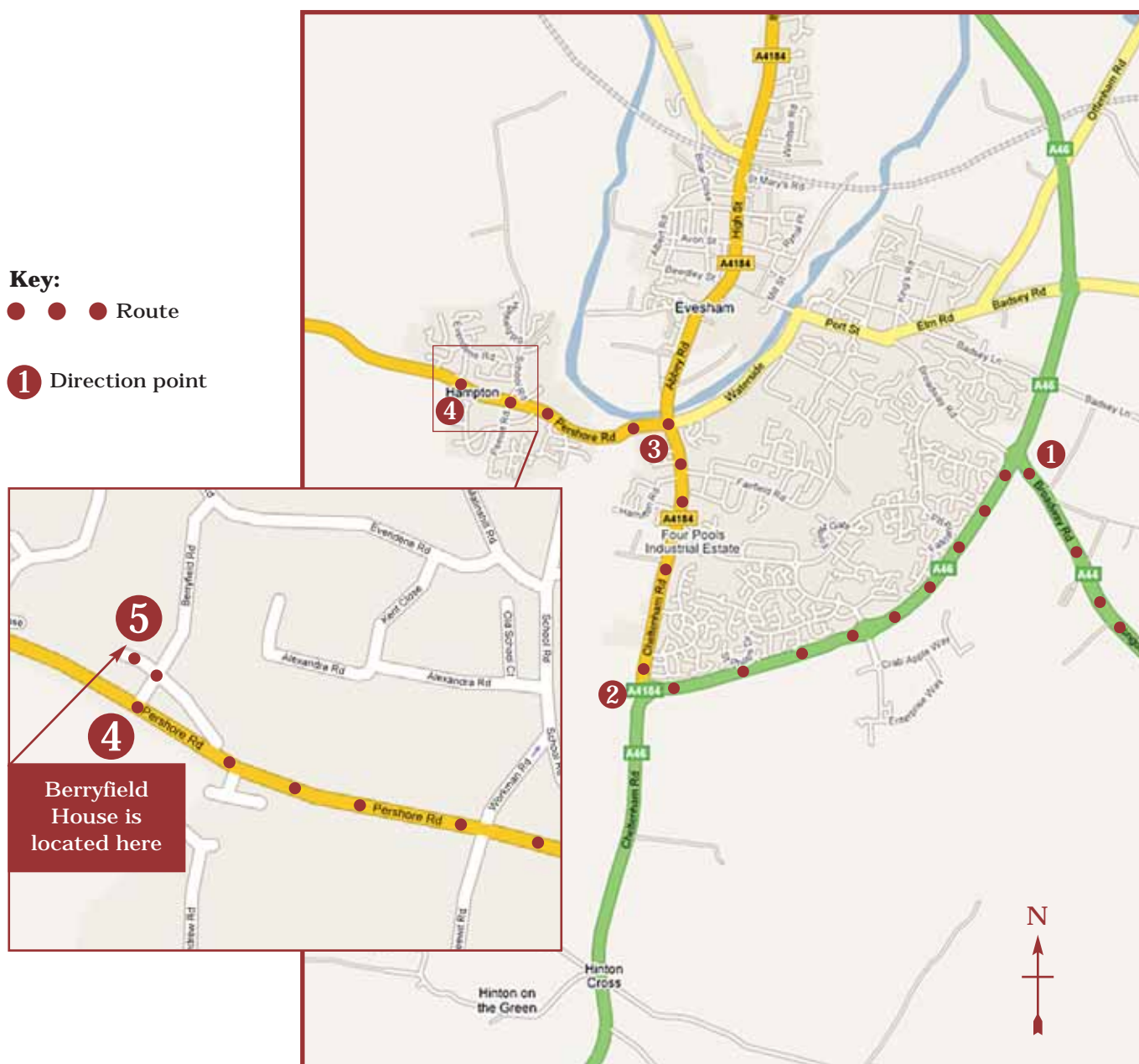
- 1 When you reach Evesham take the first left off the roundabout following the A4184 towards the town centre. (Watch out for the speed camera).
- 2 At the bottom of the hill before crossing the river turn left at the traffic lights onto the B4084.
- 3 After 0.7miles turn right into Berryfield Road, and then immediate left.
- 4 Berryfield House will be on your right.

From Oxford on the A44

From Oxford follow the A44 towards Evesham

- 1 At the roundabout where the A44 meets the A46 turn left and follow the signs towards Cheltenham.
- 2 At the second roundabout turn right onto the A4184 towards Evesham town centre. (Watch out for the speed camera).
- 3 At the bottom of the hill before crossing the river turn left at the traffic lights onto the B4084.
- 4 After 0.7miles turn right into Berryfield Road, and then immediate left.
- 5 Berryfield House will be on your right.
